



RULES FOR THE CONTEST INVITATION ON SCIENTIFIC WORK OF CARDIOLOGICAL IMAGES

XXVI WORLD CONGRESS OF ECHOCARDIOGRAPHY AND ALLIED TECHNIQUES

- 1. The invitation is addressed to the Peruvian and International Cardiology Community interested in participating.
- 2. The core of the event is the presentation of a scientific work related to Transthoracic, Transesophageal Echocardiography, Tomography, Nuclear Medicine and / or Magnetic Resonance. The case must be original and not have been published in any media or scientific communication event.
- 3. The manuscript must be sent to email: worldechoperu20@gmail.com with the subject ABSTRACTS, no later than May 31, 2020.

This will consist of the following parts:

- a. Title: Less than 150 characters including spaces. Avoid abbreviations or acronyms.
- b. Author's page: The authors should not be more than 7, of which should be recorded the following: Full name, specify position (resident or assistant), institution where you work.
- c. Work content: The scientific method contemplates the following components.
 - i. *Summary*. It should not be greater than 300 words. It should not include abbreviations and should consist of: Background Basis, Objectives, Methods, Example, Results and Conclusions
 - ii. Introduction
 - iii. Method. It covers examples, inclusion criteria, collection and processing.
 - iv. Results
 - v. Discussion
 - vi. Conclusion

- d. Bibliography: Maximum of 5 references. References will be sorted according to order of appearance and following the standards of Vancouver 2010.
- 4. The manuscript will take a maximum of 10 A4-sized double-spaced pages with font size 12. The images will be cited in the text and may include a caption with their interpretation. Statistical tables and graphs should be the representation of the findings.
- 5. The cases with the highest score will be selected, to be introduced in a presentation (number to be determined by the organizing committee). The grading of the cases will be carried out by a jury made up of members of the International Society of Cardiovascular Ultrasound. The score is described below.
- 6. The presentation of winning works will be held during the course of the event, at a location designated in the congress. Each participant will have 15 minutes available to do their presentation.
- 7. Each scientific work will be scored from 1 to 10, in the following aspects:
- a. *Originality*: refers to the novel and innovative case and / or the clinical-diagnostic approach applied to it.
- b. *Presentation*: refers to the quality of the presentation by the speaker. It involves both the evaluation of the spoken presentation and the content of the written material (PowerPoint).
- c. Images: refers to the quality and clarity of the images presented.
- d. *Coherence*: refers to the degree of correlation between the findings of the different methods, and the type and sequence of the diagnostic methods applied.
- e. Clinical message: refers to the clinical applicability that arises from the case in question.
